It all takes place at the Brewery, a renovated industrial space downtown and one of the largest artist colonies in the world. This compound has a little bit of everything—apartments, studios and a [restaurant](#)—and this coming weekend marks the biannual free [Brewery Art Walk](#).

One of the best parts of open houses is the thrill of discovery, and there's always a surprising range of work featured at the Brewery. Home decor buffs will like the large collection of modernist table and floor lamps by [Peri Shefik](#) as well as a selection of colorful abstract paintings by [Joshua Elias](#) and [Emily Halpern](#). Even more dramatic are modern metal and wood sculptures by [Bruce Gray](#).

There's wearable art, too, like contemporary jewelry by [Claudia Endler](#) and [Leoworks Jewelry](#) and the bright, flattering batik scarves of [DreamLuxe](#) by [Javier Granados](#).

We'll be on the lookout for something great to purchase—artists will be selling works at discounted prices. At the very least, we plan to chat up some of our city's cleverest residents.
